Remain at scene with other party.

Check for injuries.

Call tow truck, if car can't move.

HOW TO REPORT


Call 911, if:

a.) anyone is injured

b.) damage to all vehicles appears to be more than \$2000

c.) you believe anyone involved in the accident has committed an offence, such as DUI

- Other drivers' contact info
- Other drivers' insurance
 - Witnesses' contact info
 - Photos of damages
- Photos of injuries
- Photos of scene
- Intersection of incident
- Vehicles' travelling directions

REMINDERS

d.) unsure if you should or not, to be on the safe side

Go to Collision Reporting Centre, if:

a.) you didn't report to police

Inform your insurance company.

Speak with your broker for deductible and coverage details.

Reporting doesn't always mean you have to file a claim.

Insurance companies determine fault; police determine offences.
